

Play: Toes on Ten! (for 2 players)

Cut out the tiles below and place them, shuffled, face down in a pile. (You may wish to store them in an envelope for future use.) Each player gets 10 pennies. One player is "heads" and one player is "tails". Each player selects the top tile off the pile, reads the word shown, and covers the lily pad showing the word selected. Then, the word is placed face up in a discard pile. When all of the tiles have been selected, the pile is re-shuffled and placed face down again. If a penny with "heads" is already on a lily pad, a second "heads" penny can not be placed on it - only a "tails" penny. So, if a player selects a word that he or she has already selected, the player still reads the word but the turn is forfeited and the next player selects a card. The goal of the game is for the player to cover each of the lily pads with one of his or her game pieces. The first player to cover each of the lily pads with his or her pennies wins. (Sometimes it is fun to let the winner keep all 20 pennies!)
