
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
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





Sue and Tim woke up. It was June and the sun was hot. It was time to have fun. It was time to cool off.



Sue and Tim put on swim suits. Sue's swim suit was cute. Tim's swim suit was blue.






Sue and Tim ran in the waves.

Mom said, "I will sit here and wait for the tide to come in. Then, I will wet my toes and cool my feet."




The tide came in. The sun was due to set.

Comprehension (discussion with reader)


- 1. What was the weather like when Sue and Tim woke up?

- 3. Why did Sue want to nap at the very end of the story? Do you rest your body after playing?
