


Clark and his mother got into the car.

"Today is your third birthday," said Mom. "Let's go to the park."




It was not far. The park was down the lane, past the barn. It was near the church.




"Dad is working on the farm. At noon, he will meet us for lunch," said Mom.

"We will all eat lunch and have birthday cake. The weather is beautiful today. I know it will not storm," said Mom.




Mom made hot dogs and corn chips to eat. Clark loved hot dogs. His father liked them, too.




Soon, they got to the park.


