When you turn off your light, on a dark, moonlit night,




look left and look right, at what is in sight.

## Comprehension (discussion with reader)


- 1. What kinds of things does the little boy notice in the night sky? (clouds, stars, moon, plane)

- What do you think it means to tuck your thoughts all away? (go to sleep)
- 4. What will happen while the boy sleeps? (night will turn to day)

#### **Conversation Time**

- 1. Do you dream when you sleep? What kinds of things do you dream about? What do you think dreams are?
- 2. Do you know what rhyming words are? Can you and your Tour Guide find rhyming words in this story?
- 3. This story tells about night turning into a new day. Do you know how many days are in each of the twelve months?
- 4. Listen to the song entitled, "Thirty Days Has September", and learn a fun way to remember how many days are in each month of the year.
