




Moss was on a big log. The big log was on the wet sod.




Tom, the fox, sat on top of the log. Meg, the dog, sat with Tom.







The box was big. What was in the box? Was a top in the box?

Comprehension (discussion with reader)


- 1. Who is Tom? Who is Meg?

Conversation Time

- 1. Do you know what moss is? (a type of plant that grows on moist or damp surfaces)
- 2. Do you know what sod is? (grass with the dirt underneath it)
- 3. A fox's home is called a den. A fox den is somewhat like a large, underground hole. Foxes generally live in forest areas. Foxes live with their babies in dens. A baby fox is called a cub or a kit.
- 4. Foxes eat mice, bird eggs, large insects and small animals. They are good runners and are quite fast.
