










Huff and puff!

Comprehension (discussion with reader)

- 1. In the beginning of the story, Gus had a big frown on his face. Why?
- 2. Who are Gus's friends?
- 3. What do Gus's friends do to help Gus?
- 4. Does Gus become happy at the end? Why?
- 5. How can you tell that Gus is happy?

Conversation Time

- 1. Have you ever taken a ride on a bus?
- 2. Buses and cars need gas (or fuel) to run, just as you need food. Food is like fuel for our bodies.
- 3. Buses are one type of *transportation*. Can you think of other ways that people get from one place to another? (boats, airplanes, bicycles, trains, motorcycles, trucks, cars)
- 4. Have you ever played on a team, or watched a team play a sport? Sometimes, the players help each other. The characters in this story helped each other, too. Fuzz and Bud acted as a team to help Gus. Now, Gus can take Fuzz and Bud for a nice ride! Canyou think of a time when you helped someone in need or someone who was sad? Can you think of a time when teamwork made something good happen?
